

#### What are your duties as a Visiting Professor at UNINA?

If you are reading this guide, probably you already know which your duties are. Your duties as a Visiting Professor are established in Art. 5 of the "Regulations for Visiting Professor -Visiting Researcher - Visiting Fellow" (last modified on July 01, 2019) of the University of Naples Federico II:

- 1. Comply with the teaching program or research activities agreed with the University Contact Professor;
- 2. Follow all internal University provisions, including the provisions on workplace safety;
- 3. At the end of your stay and in agreement with the Contact Professor, write a report on the activities carried out at the University of Naples, including a list of the expenses. This report must to be sent to the International Relations Office, addressed to the Rector.

In case your agreement includes also teaching activities, the report must be accompanied by a register of the lessons held

- 4. Be in possession of the Italian tax code Fiscal Code) issued by the Agenzia delle Entrate (Tax Office);
- 5. Prove that you have health insurance coverage for civil liability and accidents (NOTE: the costs for health insurance must be covered directly by the Visitor).
